

How to transfer your MT4 profile to a new installation of MT4

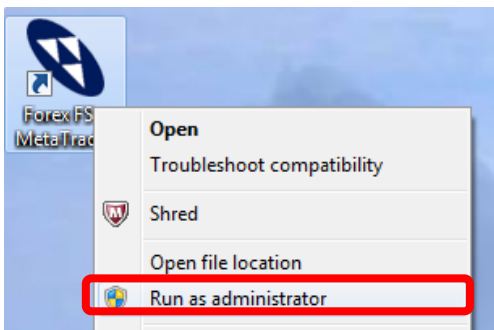
1. First install the new version of MT4 on your computer by following this link:

<http://www.forexfs.com/pages/download-mt4-on-pc.php>

Ensure you save the new instance of the program in a clearly marked folder. For example **“MT4 Instance 2”**.

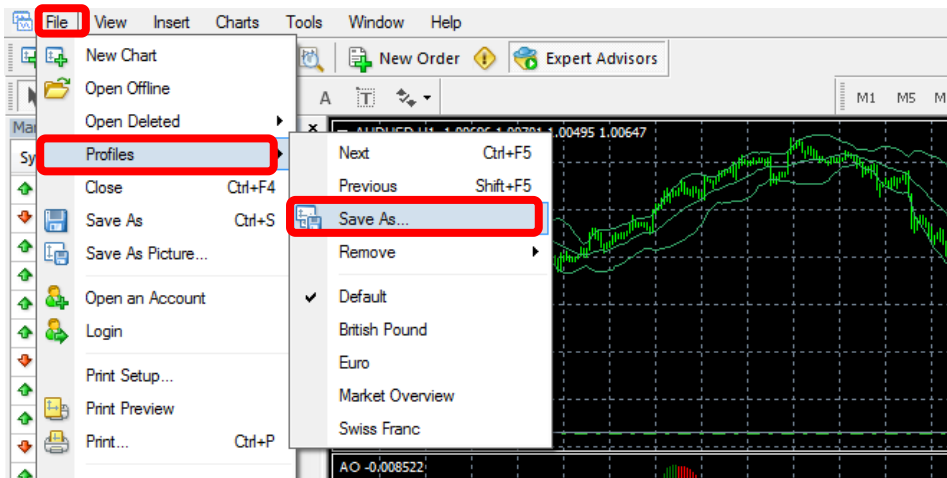
2. Next you will need to run your old MT4 instance in administrator mode.

Ensure all MT4 Platforms are completely turned off then **right click** on the old MT4 platform icon and select **“Run as administrator”**.

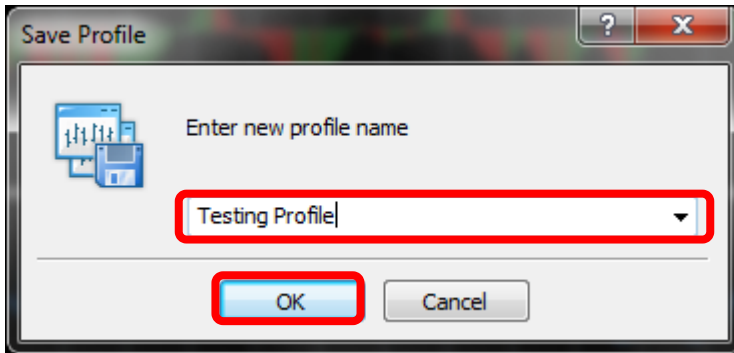


3. Now you will need to save your MT4 profile.

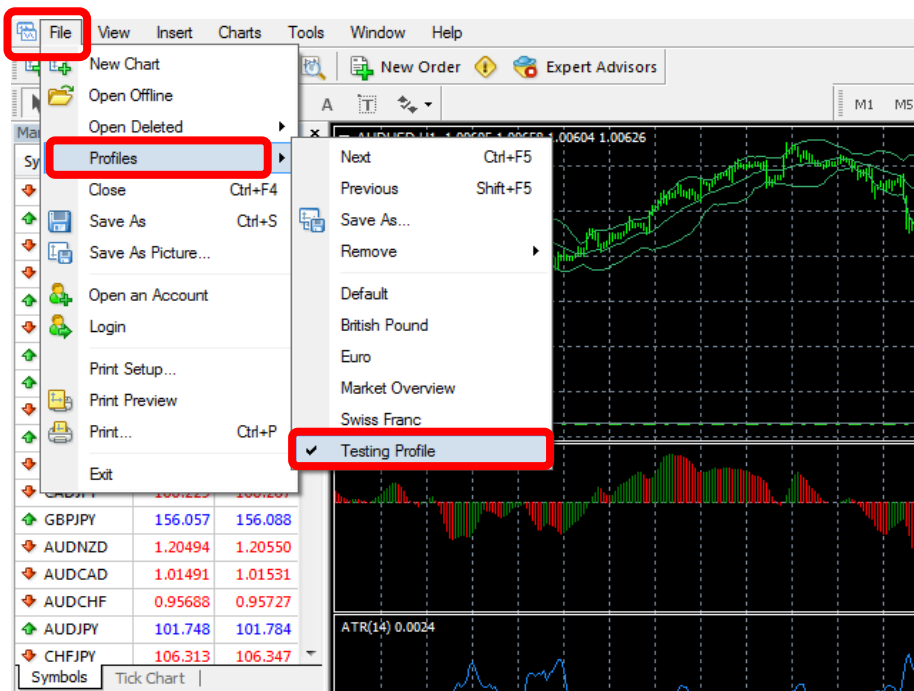
Save your profile in the MT4 platform by clicking on **“File” --> “Profiles” --> “Save As”**.



In the pop up window, enter a profile name of your choosing and click “OK”. In this case we have used “Testing Profile”.



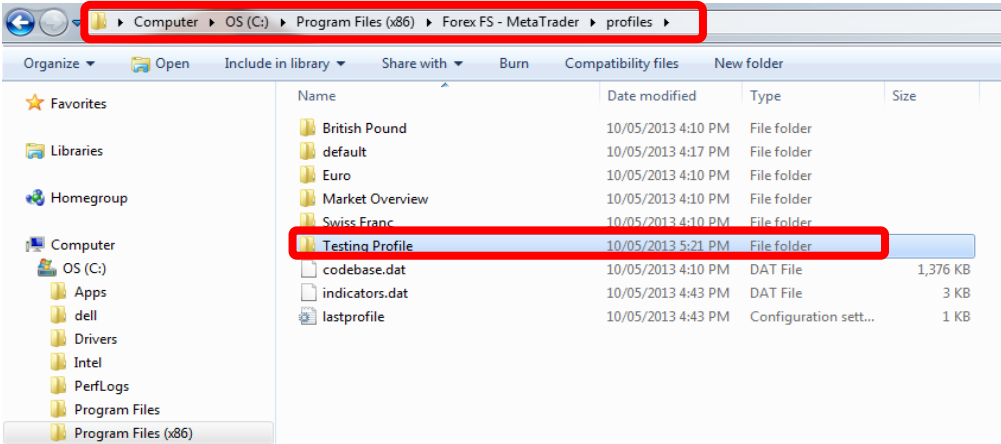
To check that the profile is saved correctly, click on “File” --> “Profiles” and ensure that your saved profile is there.



Check that your profile is also saved within the **Profiles folder** in your older Forex FS – MetaTrader folder.

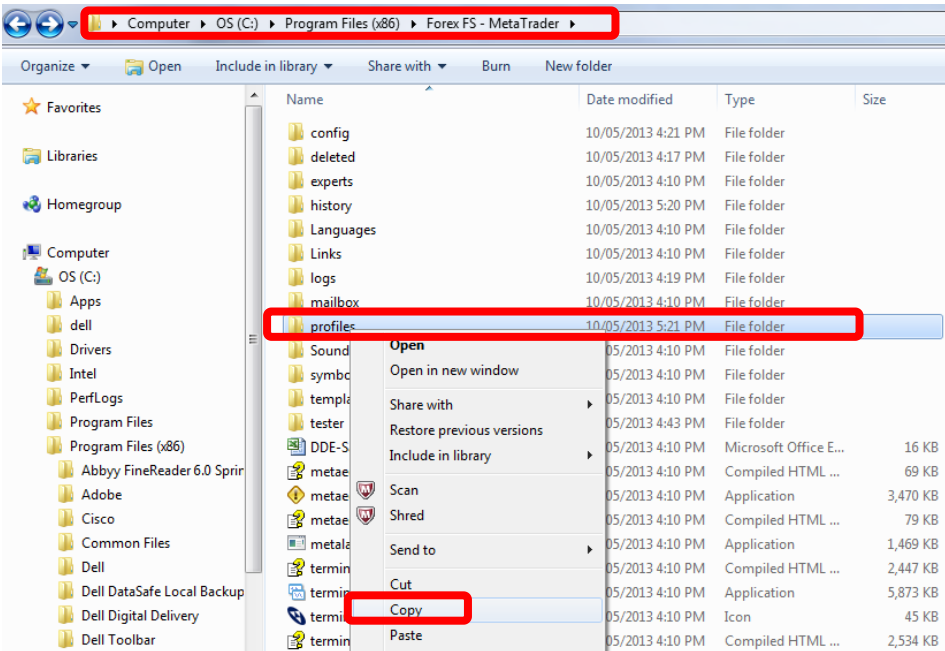
This would generally be located within your Program Files as seen below.

C:\Program Files (x86)\Forex FS - MetaTrader\Profiles

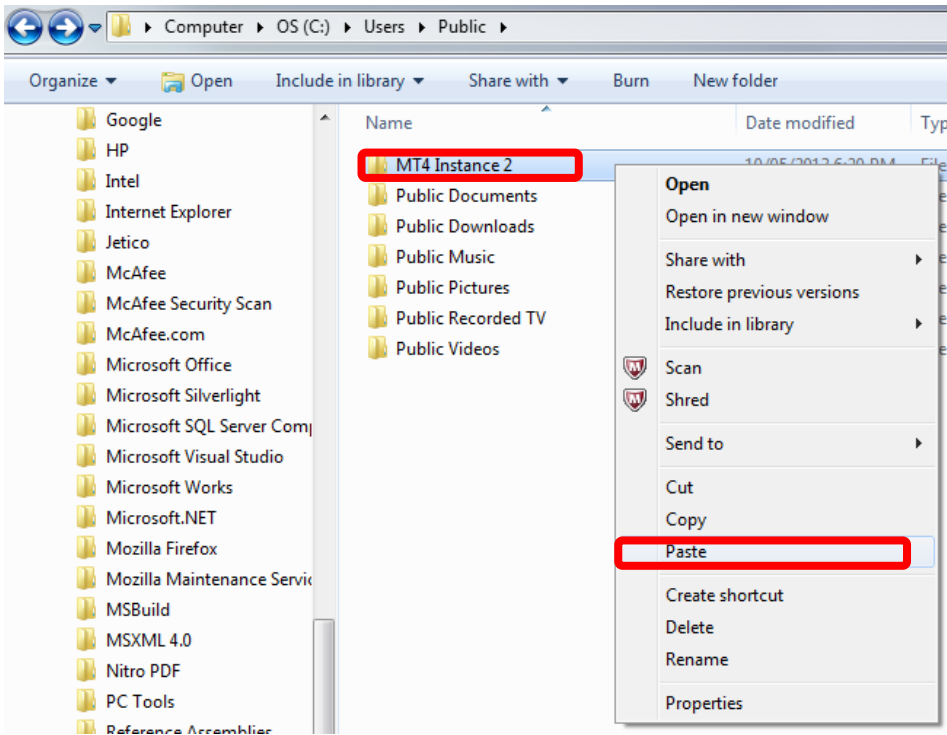


4. The final step is to move the entire Profiles folder from your original installation of MetaTrader to the location of your new installation of MetaTrader.

To do this **right click on Profiles** in the original installation folder and click **“Copy”**.



Finally go to the new installation of MetaTrader4, **right click** on the folder of the new installation of MetaTrader4 and select **“Paste”**.



Now launch the **new instance of MT4** and open the saved profile by clicking on **“File” --> “Profiles”** and selecting **“Testing Profile”**.
